Amiodarone's action and side effects: 6 P's: Prolongs action potential duration Photosensitivity Pigmentation of skin Peripheral neuropathy Pulmonary alveolitis and fibrosis Peripheral conversion of T4 to T3 is inhibited -> hypothyroidism	MAOIs indications: MAOI'S: Melancholic [classic name for atypical depression] Anxiety Obesity disorders [anorexia, bulimia] Imagined illnesses [hypochondria] Social phobias _ Listed in decreasing order of importance. _ Note MAOI is inside MelAnchOIIc
